Job Description

Job Grade: Operational Services Grade 5

Job Purpose

Responsible for leading the planning, recruitment, organisation and coaching of the Men's Futsal programme at Loughborough University and the International Futsal Academy (IFA), in conjunction with Loughborough University's Football Strategy, with specific responsibility for coaching the IFA, BUCS 1st team and the National Futsal Series teams (Tiers One and Two).

Background

The role will include coaching, leadership, recruitment and administration. The post holder will work closely with other members of Loughborough Sport and the IFA, and liaise with several internal departments including the Athletic Union (AU) and the Loughborough Students' Futsal Club Committee. They will also be tasked with creating, building and developing relationships with external partners including England Futsal, The FA, County FA's, BUCS and the National Futsal Series.

Key tasks

The role will encompass several key areas of operation for the Men's futsal squad(s). As directed by the Director of Football and the Director of the IFA:

- Develop and deliver the key actions as highlighted in Loughborough's football strategy.
- Coach the BUCS first, T1 and T2 National Futsal Series teams and IFA technical sessions.
- Lead on the management of performance services for Loughborough Students Futsal Club and the IFA.
- In conjunction with the AU Committee support the smooth running of the AU Futsal club.
- Manage the Futsal Operations placement student to ensure the futsal programme has seamless operational logistics e.g. facilities, travel, kit and other training / game day logistics.
- Ensure there is a quality futsal offer for everybody that wants to play at Loughborough, supporting a pathway from recreation, through IMS and the AU club into the performance programmes.
- Coordinate regular performance and personal development contact with the players.
- Actively lead on recruitment for performance futsal in Loughborough in conjunction with the IFA,
 Loughborough Students Futsal Club and Loughborough Sport. Establish relationships with colleges, clubs,

community trust programmes and associations to develop pathway partnerships into Loughborough. Management of recruitment activity such as open days, tours and club / college visits.

- In consultation with the Director of Football, Football Programme Manager, the IFA and relevant SU Committees ensure the club has suitable coaches throughout the Men's Futsal programme.
- Ensure that the programme promotes the mission and values of sport at Loughborough.

General Requirements

- Contribute to the sharing of coaching ideas and skills within the high-performance educational forums available on campus.
- Actively work to promote Loughborough University sport and the Loughborough Students Futsal Club generally.

Points To Note

The purpose of this job description is to indicate the general level of duties and responsibility of the post. The detailed duties may vary from time to time without changing the general character or level of responsibility entailed.

Special Conditions

It will be necessary to work outside normal working hours including work in the evening and at weekends.
